Class 1: Saturday, November 19, 2011; 4-6pm: Exploring Spain

One of the most popular classes I offer. Exploring Spain takes you inside the fascinating wines of Spain, both white and red. I will profile wines from the top wine regions as well as the emerging regions. You will learn the style of wines that each region is known for to better help you select wines when shopping. You will also learn tips in reading Spanish wine labels and understanding the wine classification system

Class 2: Saturday, January 14, 2012; 4-6pm: The Best of Chile and Argentina

Experience first hand the uniqueness and tremendous value that exists in these two South American wine producing countries. See how the Andes Mountains influences each region in a unique way. We will explore why the wines from these countries are in high demand and learn which regions are known for what grape varieties. For whites, discover the great Sauvignon Blancs and red Bordeaux varieties from Chile and Torrontes and Malbecs from Argentina.

Class 3: Saturday, February 11, 2012; 4-6pm: Cabernet Sauvignon Uncorked

This not to be missed class highlights the most noble of red grape varieties, Cabernet Sauvignon. We will explore wines from the top Cabernet producing regions in the world: California, Bordeaux and Washington as well as Cabernet blends from Italy and Australia. Learn what attributes make this such an expressive and ageworthy wine.
